Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had an exciting few weeks with lots of school trips and activities taking place. COVID update / illness

You will have seen from Colin Cox's letter to parents on the 7th March 2022 that there is no requirement for household contacts to isolate and that children who are household contacts can attend school as normal. However, it is important to stress that individuals who test positive are still strongly advised to stay home for 5 days and use lateral flow testing from day 5 to see if they are able to return to school. We do continue to have positive cases within school so it is also important to note that individuals who present with any of the 3 main symptoms of coronavirus (persistent cough, high temperature, loss of taste or smell) should not attend school and should seek a PCR test.

Red Nose Day – Friday 18th March 2022

A reminder that tomorrow is Red Nose Day and that children can wear non-uniform for a suggested donation of £1 for Comic Relief.

Scholastic Book Fair – Monday 21st March to Thursday 24th March 2022
