Re: Children's Cancer Run, Bitts Park, Carlisle.

The 2nd Children's Cancer Run 2022 will be taking place on Sunday 26th June in Bitts Park, Carlisle. Your child's school have signed up to the event, giving your school community an opportunity to receive information and details about the day and how to sign up.

The Children's Cancer Run is a cross-country family fun run with one, three and five mile routes to choose from. The charity event is organised by Children's Cancer North to raise funds for research into better treatments for childhood cancer and to support families of children and young people whilst they are going through treatment. We are very excited to be supporting this event and would like to invite you to join us for what promises to be a fun filled family day out. All participants receive a limited edition medal and snack pack on the day, and all children receive a limited edition t-shirt. The event also offers live music, food stalls, a mini funfair and entertainment from CFM Radio.

Please complete an on-line entry form to join our team (school is not able to complete your entry):

1. Log on to www.childrencancerrun.co.uk
2. **Select** the Carlisle event and choose 'Sign me up'
3. Complete your entry form, selecting our school name from the drop down list
4. Click **proceed to payment** to complete the registration for you and your family

Please note that the three and five mile courses are suitable for children over 7 years old. All children must be supervised by an adult (parents can accompany their children on the Mini Mile without registering but please register if you would like to receive a medal and snack pack).

We would encourage you to do what you can in order to raise sponsorship; while your entry fee covers the cost of the event, it is your sponsorship that will make a difference in making life better for children and young people with cancer in the North East and Cumbria. Please raise funds using either the paper sponsor forms that will be provided in your run pack, or the on-line fundraising page created when you register on-line.
