Dear Parents and Carers,

The end of this half term is fast approaching and the term has already been jam-packed with exciting events. I would also like to extend a well deserved "well done" to our Year 6 class who have just completed their Key Stage 2 Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs). The continuing hard work and perseverance of all our children after two years of disrupted education should be commended!

### Outdoor Classroom Day – Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> May 2022

We are hopeful that we have a dry day on Thursday as the classes will be spending some time outside for Outdoor Classroom Day. As the weather is changeable, we do ask that the children are prepared for all eventualities. They will require uniform as normal (or PE kit if that is their timetabled day) but will need a waterproof coat and wellies in school if wet. Similarly, sun cream and a sun hat may also be required if we are lucky enough to have the sun shining!

### COVID-19

The guidance from Cumbria Public Health relating to COVID-19 is that, if a child under the age of 18 tests positive for COVID-19, they should stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 3 days after the day they took the test. In addition, children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and where possible avoid contact with other people. They can return to school when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to do so.

### Illness / Scarlet Fever

Unfortunately, there are a number of childhood illnesses that can circulate amongst children and we do currently have a case of Scarlet Fever linked to the setting.
