Farewell to Mrs Ager!

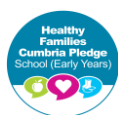

School meals and milk

Unfortunately, due to rising supplier costs, we are having to introduce a price increase in regards to our school milk and school meals. From September, the cost of a school dinner will be £2.40 and milk will become 20p per carton. Payments for these will continue to be made via School Money and please do let us know if you have any queries in regards to this. We consider these to still offer excellent value for money in the present economic climate.



Breakfast Club price increase

A couple of years ago, we changed our Breakfast Club start time from 8am to 7.45am to give parents more flexibility but did not alter the price accordingly. Due to rising costs, we do need to increase the cost of the Breakfast Club session to £2.50 from September.

Important safety reminder

A polite reminder that we do encourage a one-way system through the village to help reduce congestion. We ask parents to enter High Hesket at the Penrith end of the village and exit at the Carlisle end. We do also ask that vehicles do not block the pavements or driveways and the bus bay must only be used as a 'drop and stop' area. In addition to this, I have had some concerning reports that children have been witnessed not crossing the roads in a safe manner at times and I would urge all parents to ensure their children are supervised when walking along the pavements or crossing the road. It can be particularly busy at certain times of the school day and the number of vehicles travelling through can cause difficulties with visibility. The safety of our pupils is paramount so please do take care when dropping off and picking up outside school.

PTA events

A huge 'thank you' for your recent support with our Summer Term PTA events. As mentioned previously, the 'Day off day' was a huge success and I can now share that it raised in excess of £1400! This money goes directly to funding resources for the children and we are incredibly grateful for all contributions. The PTA 'tea and cake' afternoon in celebration of the Platinum Jubilee was also very well supported and we need to congratulate our Reception Class for their hard work in hosting the event.
