Dear Parents and Carers,

We have been incredibly impressed with the maturity and thoughtfulness that the children have demonstrated over the last few days following the announcement of the death of Queen Elizabeth II. Children have had the opportunity to engage in conversations held in their classes and the children have asked respectful, considered questions. It has been a period of reflection for many and we continue to send our thoughts to King Charles III and the royal family.

Bank Holiday – Monday 19th September 2022

As a result of the announcement that there will be a national bank holiday to observe the funeral of Queen Elizabeth II, school will be closed on Monday 19th September 2022.

Harvest Festival – Wednesday 28th September 2022

We have provisionally booked St Mary's Church, High Hesket, on Wednesday 28th September 2022 in order to hold our Harvest festival services for children in Reception – Year 6. Traditionally, we have always invited parents to watch the service and then join us for a light Harvest lunch in the school afterwards. Due to the size of the church, we normally have two performances (Rec-Y3 / Y4-6) to accommodate the number of children and parents. We are hoping to invite parents in again this year and are just finalising arrangements for how this will be organised. Further information will be sent out soon but you may wish to make a note of this date in your diaries in case you are able to make it.

Food items in school

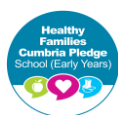
