We're really excited that the Christmas Fair is making a return in 2022, after a three year absence. It will be held on:

**Friday 2nd Dec
4:45pm – 6:30pm
£2 per adult entry (children free).**

This year, we will have card payments available (subject to a small processing fee), and we will be operating a token system for payment at each stall. Tokens will be 50p each, and will be available to buy on entry to the fair, or at our token stand. We will have pre-bagged amounts available, but tokens can be bought in any value. As this is our first year taking card payments, cash is also still very welcome!

Your entry fee includes a drink and a mince pie.

Donations

We're trying a few new stalls this year, and we continue to need your generous donations. These include:

- Mince pies
- Cakes for our cake stall
- Bottles of alcohol for our bottle tombola (please hand in to the school office)
- Raffle prizes (which can include alcohol – if handed to the office).
