Local Government Reorganisation

This may mean that some of the services and external professionals who we currently work with may change from April but we will keep parents informed of any relevant changes as we receive further information.

As explained in previous letters, we will not have confirmed staffing levels until the actual day of action so we may have to make last minute changes if necessary.
