#### **Statutory Assessment Tests**

Over the next couple of weeks, our Year 2 children will also be completing their End of Key Stage 1 assessments and, during June, both Year 1 and Year 4 will also complete their national statutory assessments. Year 1 will take part in the phonics screening check whilst Year 4 will complete the multiplication check. Wherever possible, we try to deliver the assessments in as relaxed and as low key a way as possible and the results of all assessments will be shared in the children's end of term reports in July.
