This is rotated around the school in order that each class has two half terms with the coach per year. Teachers stay with the coach in order that their skill and confidence increases.<br>Each class, from Year one upwards have a block of 5 weeks gymnastics each year. This is held at Morton Academy and run by a special coach. All children's confidence and participation has improved as a result of these activities. |

All children leave school being confident with swimming at least 25m. Coaches are provided to maximise differentiated group work.  |

After School Clubs                   | £520                                | To increase participation in after school sports clubs and raise the profile and enjoyment of sport.<br>To increase fitness levels and impact on healthy lifestyles                                      | Our coach runs an afterschool club one day a week which offers a variety of different sports during the year. Many children participate in this club building confidence and adding enjoyment. In addition healthy lifestyles and fitness levels are promoted.   |

Transport                            | £2610<br>+ £350<br>staff<br>support | To enable participation in a range of sporting activities, specialist equipment and facilities thus increasing participation, enjoyment, confidence and skill.   | Sports funding has been used to subsidise the cost of travel to ensure our children have access to sports activities, competitions, festivals and swimming. This ensured children experienced a broader range of activities as well as healthy competition and contact with children from different schools aiding transition.   |
