### Home Learning for Y6

We hope all continues to be well with you and your family. We are, as you will be aware from Mrs Harvey's communications, unsure if and when the Y6 children will be able to return to school. With this in mind we would like to ensure we engage with the children as much as possible this half term.

We are conscious that throughout this term we would be spending much of our time preparing our Y6 children for their transition to Secondary School and so would like to do this remotely. Alongside the usual home learning projects on the Y6 webpage you will also see we have posted a Y6 transition project. This is composed of the sorts of activities we would undertake with the children, if we were in school. Each week we will explore a different focus and provide activities to help the children to reflect, plan and look forward to their next steps. This can be an exciting but nerve wracking time for many children and we hope to support them as best we can.

In addition to the projects, there are two further things we would like to involve the children in. We plan to hold fortnightly Zoom meetings, where we will use the transition projects to discuss their reflections on their time at High Hesket and their thoughts on their move to Secondary School. We will provide further information about how this will work in due course. We will ask the children to share elements of their transition projects with us so that we can put together a Year 6 video for them to keep as we will be unable to hold our usual Year 6 leaver's production. It would be lovely if the children could engage with us through Tapestry or the Homework email. Again, further information about this will follow.

You may decide to use the transition project instead of the other learning projects provided but we would strongly recommend continuing with some elements of the English and Maths.

Home learning and transition projects will continue to be uploaded on Fridays for the following week, as we are aware some families appreciate the weekend to plan for the next week's activities.

We do hope that you and your family continue to stay safe and well. We are all missing the children greatly and look forward to when the school can open more fully again.
