COVID-19 update

As winter approaches, please remember that children who have any of the 3 symptoms of COVID-19 (cough, high temperature and/or loss of taste or smell) should not attend school and, if symptoms are present, should seek a PCR test. We do know that regular cold and flu symptoms will be doing the rounds but, especially now that we are seeing positive cases within the school community, we need to ask everyone's support in remaining vigilant. We are aware that COVID-19 can also present with a wide variety of additional symptoms so do request that children do not come in to school if they are unwell.
